## WHY GUESS WHEN YOU CAN SEE WHAT THE DEALER HAS DOWN UNDER?

Down Under Blackjack lets you see the strength of the dealer's hand before you decide how to play your own hand. Before the player acts, the dealer will identify his down card as being Small, Medium or Large by placing the hand on one of the color-coded areas.

BLUE $=2,3,4$, or 5
RED $=6,7,8$, or 9
GOLD $=10, \mathbf{J}, \mathbf{Q}, \mathrm{~K}$, or $\mathbf{A}$

Once the dealer's given you this extra information you can use it to your advantage!

## BLACKJACK RULES APPLY

- Dealer hits any total of soft 17, and stands on soft 18 (or larger) or hard 17 (or larger)
- Blackjack pay 3:2
- Player may split any pair a total of three (3) times
- Split Aces receive only one (1) card each
- Player may double on any two (2) card total
- Player may double after a split
- No Insurance or Surrender offered


## ALL HANDS PUSH AGAINST A DEALER 22, EXCEPT FOR THE GOLDEN RULE

- Dealer hits any total of soft 17, and stands on soft 18 (or larger) or hard 17 (or larger)
- Blackjack pay 3:2
- Player may split any pair a total of three (3) times
- Split Aces receive only one (1) card each
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## HOW TO PLAY

The player makes a Match the Dealer wager by placing a bet in the Match the Dealer bet circle. In order to play Match the Dealer, the player must make a regular 21 bet. If either or both a player's first two cards exactly match the dealer's up card in rank (a four matches a four, jack matches only jack, queen matches only queen, etc.) the player wins an amount per the table payoff below.

Minimum bet is $\$ 1$, the house sets the maximum.

## FIVE BIG PAYOFFS

1 Non-Suited Match: Pays ..... 4-1
2 Non-Suited Matches: Pays ..... 8-1
1 Suited Match: Pays ..... 11-1
1 Non-Suited \& 1 Suited Match: Pays ..... 15-1
2 Suited Matches: Pays ..... 22-1
